Action Projects to Promote Community Engagement

Tepe Park neighbors are joining together to harness the power of community to revitalize our neighborhood and we need your help. Our neighbors are real people with names, stories and gifts to share—knowledge, abilities, talents, skills and passions. When we are connected, we have the power and ability to create the change we want to see in our neighborhood.

Neighborhood Action Projects put direct investments into the hands of neighbors to help resource them to be the change they hope to see. From March 18th through April 22nd, we will accept applications for projects. If you are a resident with a solution, you are eligible to apply!

NEIGHBORHOOD ACTION PROJECT GOALS

To have an immediate and positive impact on the quality of life in the neighborhood.	To activate residents of all backgrounds in the neighborhood vision.
To bring resident's ideas to life through resources and funding.	To launch quick win projects that can be completed with \$250 - \$1,000

GUIDELINES

- Projects must engage and bring together residents throughout the Tepe Park neighborhood, and/or provide visible results in the short term (3 - 6 months).
- Funding requests must be for new projects or an expansion of an existing project.
- Applicants need to show a clear connection between the project proposal and the aspirational goals/projects in the Love Your Neighborhood initiative.
- Applicants must explain how the project will contribute, at least in some small way, toward making Tepe Park a great place to live in the long-term.

PROCESS

1. Resident(s) complete the project application and submit for review.
2. Those reviewing proposals may contact applicants regarding the projects, which could include meeting(s), phone conversations, and/or electronic correspondence.
3. Applicants may need to give a brief presentation (3 - 4 minutes) and answer questions about their project to the Selection Committee.
4. Grant awards will be announced at the May TPNA meeting. Awardees will be informed of the decision by phone or email, and a list of awardees will be posted on the Tepe Park Facebook page - @TepeParkNeighborhoodAssociation.
5. Community One will draft an agreement and send to the applicant via mail. Once the agreement is signed and returned, funds will be distributed directly to the awardees. This process usually takes 2 - 4 weeks to complete.
6. A brief report describing results is required no later than 6 months after project funds are distributed. Project pictures must be included with the report.
